Mr. Nyland retired from IBM Corporation in October 2008, where he spent his entire working career, holding leadership positions in the Public Sector and Government business units. Most recently, Nyland was General Manager and Managing Partner of the Public Sector, managing a team of 5,000 professionals that provide consulting and systems integration services to US Federal agencies, state and local governments, health care organizations and educational institutions. For the last 10 years of his career, he was also IBM's senior location executive for the Washington DC metropolitan area. In 2000, Mr. Nyland joined IBM Global Services. During the mid 1990's, he led IBM's US Federal sales organization. Mr. Nyland began his career in IBM's Federal Systems Division in Owego, NY in 1977.

Mr. Nyland is a member of the board of trustees of the University of Maryland Foundation. He also serves on the boards of Notable Solutions Inc (NSI) of Rockville, MD and Oculis Labs of Hunt Valley, MD. He has been active in the Maryland technology community for the past 18 years. He is the former chairman and currently chairman emeritus of the Technology Council of Maryland (TCM), a non-profit organization of over 500 Maryland based companies. Mr. Nyland is also a former board member of the Maryland Business Roundtable, and he co-chaired the IT Division of the Maryland Governor's Workforce Investment Board. In addition, he has also served on Michigan State University's Eli Broad School of Business advisory board.

Mr. Nyland received his Bachelor of Arts degree (1975) in Business Administration and his Masters of Business Administration degree (1977) from Michigan State University.
